



CHAPTER 138

An Act to authorize the Montreal Trust Company and Dame Jeanne Elizabeth d'Alton, as executors and trustees under the last will and testament of the late Roland Wentworth Tupper Robb, in his lifetime of the town of Mount Royal, district of Montreal, to withdraw certain moneys from the capital of the estate

[Assented to, the 19th of February, 1932]

WHEREAS the Montreal Trust Company and Dame Preamble.

Jeanne Elizabeth d'Alton, widow of the late Roland Wentworth Tupper Robb, in their quality as executors and trustees under the last will and testament of the said late Roland Wentworth Tupper Robb, have, by their petition, set forth that by his last will and testament, executed in the form derived from the laws of England, on the 14th of October, 1924, and duly probated on the 24th day of August, 1928, he did direct that all the income and revenues from the net balance of his estate, after payment of his debts, should be paid to his wife, the said Dame Jeanne Elizabeth d'Alton, while she lives and remains unmarried, the said net balance to be divided equally among his surviving children at the remarriage or at the death of his said wife; that on the death of the said testator on the 21st of August, 1928, he left his widow aforesaid and four minor children him surviving, and the net value of his estate, including the proceeds of insurance policies, after deducting the debts and succession duties payable, amounted to approximately thirty-three thousand nine hundred and one dollars and seventy-four cents; that the revenues from the said estate are insufficient to provide for the maintenance of the widow and for the maintenance and education of the four minor children of the deceased, and that for the next five years an annual sum of approximately one thousand

dollars will be required for such purposes; and that the said petitioners desire to be authorized to withdraw an annual sum of approximately one thousand dollars during the next five years for such purposes from the capital of the estate.

Whereas the petitioners have prayed for an act for the foregoing purposes, and

Whereas it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Withdrawal
of certain

1. The Montreal Trust Company and Dame Jeanne Elizabeth d'Alton, in their quality as executors and trustees under the last will and testament of the late Roland Wentworth Tupper Robb, are hereby authorized to withdraw annually for a period of five years dating from the first day of November, 1931, from the capital of the estate of the said late Roland Wentworth Tupper Robb, a sum not exceeding one thousand dollars for the purpose of expending the same to provide for the maintenance of the widow and for the maintenance and education of the minor children of the late Roland Wentworth Tupper Robb.

Coming into
force, etc.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction, but the authorization hereby granted shall take effect as from the 1st day of November, 1931, as aforesaid.
