



CHAPTER 149

An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to
admit J. Arsène Morin, L.S.C., to the study of law,
without examination

[Assented to, the 3rd of December, 1931]

WHEREAS J. Arsène Morin, of the city and district of Preamble.
Quebec, has, by his petition, represented:

That he is, since 1921, a graduate with distinction of the Science Course of the Mont-Saint-Louis College, of Montreal, and, since 1924, a licentiate with distinction in Commercial Sciences of the School of Higher Commercial Studies, affiliated to Montreal University;

That he is twenty-nine years of age, married and father of a family;

That he has ascertained that the subjects to qualify for the certificate of admission to the study of law are the same as those studied during his secondary and university studies and in which he passed the official examinations successfully;

That it appears, in fact, that the science courses of study and the university commercial studies which he has already had to comply with contain more than the subjects and knowledge required for the certificate;

Whereas these facts have been brought to the knowledge of the General Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec, with a statement of the studies made, and the said Council has granted the petitioner's request, asking for permission to present a bill at this session of the Legislature to admit him to the study of law, without examination;

Whereas the petitioner has prayed for the passing of an act for the above purposes, and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Bar authorized to admit J. Arsène Morin.

1. The Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit J. Arsène Morin to the study of law, without examination.

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
