



## CHAPTER 6

An Act to amend the Act respecting the construction and maintenance of a bridge over the river St. Lawrence at Caughnawaga

*[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1931]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 15*b* of the act 18 George V, chapter 110, as enacted by the act 20 George V, chapter 3, section 3, is replaced by the following:

“**15*b***. In the same contract or in any subsequent contract, it may be provided that, in case the amount of money derived from the tolls established under section 17 of this act is insufficient to cover every year at maturity the sums required to pay the annual operating and maintenance charges of the said bridge and of its approaches, the interest on any loan contracted for the purpose of constructing said bridge and its approaches and the sinking-fund of the loan, the Government shall undertake to pay the annual deficit to the corporation as long as such deficit exists, but for a period of not more than forty years.”

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
