



## CHAPTER 10

An Act to indemnify farmers for certain losses and to aid  
in the purchase of chemical fertilizers

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1931]

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to promote the use of chemi- Preamble.  
cal fertilizers and lime;

Whereas it is also expedient to indemnify the owners for  
the loss of cattle slaughtered as tuberculous or to assist  
in replacing the cattle so slaughtered;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of  
the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of  
Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** A sum of three hundred thousand dollars is set aside  
to assist the farmers of this Province in the purchase Aid for

The Provincial Treasurer is authorized to pay such sum Payment.  
of three hundred thousand dollars to the Minister of Agri-  
culture, out of the consolidated revenue fund, upon an  
order of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into
