



## CHAPTER 10

An Act to indemnify farmers for certain losses and to aid  
in the purchase of chemical fertilizers

*[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1931]*

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to promote the use of chemical fertilizers and lime; Preamble.

Whereas it is also expedient to indemnify the owners for the loss of cattle slaughtered as tuberculous or to assist in replacing the cattle so slaughtered;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** A sum of three hundred thousand dollars is set aside to assist the farmers of this Province in the purchase or transportation of the chemical fertilizers and lime required to increase production from their land, and to indemnify them for the loss of their cattle slaughtered as tuberculous or to aid them in replacing such animals so slaughtered. Aid for purchasing, etc., of chemical fertilizers. Indemnification for slaughtered cattle.

The Provincial Treasurer is authorized to pay such sum of three hundred thousand dollars to the Minister of Agriculture, out of the consolidated revenue fund, upon an order of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council. Payment.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
