



CHAPTER 24

An Act to amend the Pension Act

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1931]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Pension Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 11) R. S., c. 11, is amended by adding thereto, after section 28 thereof, the ^{s. 28a,} following section:

"28a. Every public officer or employee who has been ^{Member-} a member of the civil service for at least fifteen years and ^{ship in civil} who accepts a governmental employment or office to which ^{service con-} this act does not apply shall, for the purpose of this act, be ^{tinued in} deemed a member of the civil service provided that he ^{certain case.} continues to contribute to the pension fund by means of the annual deduction of three per cent provided for by this act.

Nevertheless, if the act governing the employment or ^{Option.} office accepted by such public officer or employee provides a pension for the holder thereof, the latter may, for the purpose of his pension, choose between the provisions of this act and those of the other act.

Such option shall be exercised by means of a notice in ^{Notice} writing to the Provincial Treasurer within the month fol- ^{thereof.} lowing such appointment."

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. ^{force.}
