



## CHAPTER 27

### An Act to amend the Quebec License Act

*[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1931]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 22 of the Quebec License Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 25), as amended by the act 20 George V, chapter 24, section 1, is again amended: R. S., c. 25,  
s. 22, am.

*a.* By striking out the words: "provided always that the duty shall not be less than five dollars", in the first, second and third lines of sub-paragraph *d* of paragraph 1 thereof;

*b.* By striking out the words: "nor less than five dollars", in the seventh line of paragraph 2 thereof;

*c.* By striking out the words: "nor less than five dollars", in the second and third lines of the second paragraph of paragraph 3 thereof;

*d.* By striking out the words: "nor less than five dollars", in the tenth line of paragraph 4 thereof.

**2.** Section 47 of the said act is amended by striking out paragraph *c* of subsection 1 thereof. Id., s. 47,  
am.

**3.** Section 92 of the said act is amended by adding to subsection 1 thereof the following paragraphs: Id., s. 92,  
am.

"The above provisions of this section shall apply to every branch established in this Province by a broker, firm of brokers or person contemplated by the said provisions, as well as to every company having its head office in this Province and doing a brokerage business therein on behalf of or for the benefit of a broker, firm of brokers or person, whose residence or chief place of business is outside the Province. Brokerage  
business.

Exceptions. The provisions of this section shall not, however, apply to a broker, firm of brokers or person who:

- a.* is a member of the Montreal Stock Exchange or of the Montreal Curb Market; or
- b.* is a member of the Investment Bankers Association of Canada."

**4.** Sections 100, 102 and 103 of the said act are repealed.

**5.** Division xiv of the said act, comprising sections 118 to 122 inclusively, is repealed.
