



## CHAPTER 48

### An Act to amend the Quebec Fisheries Act

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1931]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 4 of the Quebec Fisheries Act (Revised R. S., c. 83, Statutes, 1925, chapter 83) is amended by adding thereto, <sup>s. 4, am.</sup> after the second paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:

“The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, during the <sup>Extension of</sup> period of the existence of a lease or a license, extend the <sup>term.</sup> term thereof for a period of time not to exceed fifteen years, <sup>Proviso.</sup> provided that the lessee or licensee undertakes to perform work of a permanent nature to the satisfaction of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.”

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming into</sup> sanction. <sup>force.</sup>
