



CHAPTER 48

An Act to amend the Quebec Fisheries Act

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1931]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 4 of the Quebec Fisheries Act (Revised R. S., c. 83, Statutes, 1925, chapter 83) is amended by adding thereto, ^{s. 4, am.} after the second paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:

“The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, during the ^{Extension of} period of the existence of a lease or a license, extend the ^{term.} term thereof for a period of time not to exceed fifteen years, ^{Proviso.} provided that the lessee or licensee undertakes to perform work of a permanent nature to the satisfaction of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. ^{force.}
