



CHAPTER 49

An Act respecting the canning of fish and other sea food

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1931]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. 1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may make, Regulations
amend and repeal regulations respecting the canning of fish, etc., for can-
mollusks and crustaceans and also respecting the inspection food, etc.
of canning-factories for fish, mollusks and crustaceans, and
of such sea food intended for market.

2. The regulations under subsection 1 of this section may Permit.
provide for the issuing of a permit at a cost not exceeding
one dollar, and the renewal thereof as well as the imposi-Penalties.
tion of penalties for infringements of such regulations.

3. The expenses incurred in the carrying out of such Expenses.
regulations shall be paid out of the consolidated revenue
fund.

4. Such regulations and the changes which may be made Coming into
therein shall come into force fifteen days after their publi-force of
cation in the *Quebec Official Gazette*. regulations.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into
sanction. force.
