



CHAPTER 57

An Act to amend the Cities and Towns' Act respecting the
levying of certain taxes

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1931]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Cities and Towns' Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, R. S., c. 102,
chapter 102) is amended by inserting therein, after section
527 thereof, as amended by the act 17 George V, chapter
32, section 2, the following section:

"527a. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 526,
and without prejudice to the provisions of any special
charter of a city or town, the council may impose and levy
an annual license or permit not exceeding two hundred
dollars on merchants doing business in the municipality
and who do not reside therein or are resident therein since
less than three months and whose names are not entered
on the valuation roll as owners of immoveables, but tem-
porarily occupying premises, without, however, being
obliged to impose a tax or permit on those resident therein
since more than three months."

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its
sanction. Coming into
