



CHAPTER 71

An Act respecting the jurisdiction of certain courts in the judicial district of Nicolet

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1931]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The act 5 George V, chapter 13, is amended by inserting therein, after section 6 thereof, the following section: 5 Geo. V, c. 13, s. 6a, added.

“6a. From and after the 11th of March, 1931, the Magistrate’s Court established for the district of Nicolet shall have jurisdiction to try and determine all cases, matters or things within the competence of the Circuit Court of the county of Nicolet under a general or special act. Jurisdiction of Magistrate’s Court of Nicolet.

The provisions of the preceding paragraph shall apply to cases pending before the Circuit Court of the county of Nicolet, and to those which originated in the Magistrate’s Court established for the district of Nicolet, and which have been afterwards referred to the Circuit Court of the county of Nicolet.” Pending cases.

2. The provisions of sections 302 to 310, inclusively, of the Courts of Justice Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 145) shall apply, *mutatis mutandis*, to the cases contemplated by section 1 of this act. Provisions applicable.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
