



CHAPTER 71

An Act respecting the jurisdiction of certain courts in the
judicial district of Nicolet

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1931]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The act 5 George V, chapter 13, is amended by in-5 Geo. V, c.
serting therein, after section 6 thereof, the following section: 13, s. 6a,
added.

“**6a.** From and after the 11th of March, 1931, the Jurisdiction
Magistrate's Court established for the district of Nicolet of Magis-
shall have jurisdiction to try and determine all cases, mat- strate's
ters or things within the competence of the Circuit Court of Court of
the county of Nicolet under a general or special act. of Nicolet.

The provisions of the preceding paragraph shall apply Pending
to cases pending before the Circuit Court of the county of cases.
Nicolet, and to those which originated in the Magistrate's
Court established for the district of Nicolet, and which
have been afterwards referred to the Circuit Court of the
county of Nicolet.”

2. The provisions of sections 302 to 310, inclusively, of Provisions
the Courts of Justice Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter applicable.
145) shall apply, *mutatis mutandis*, to the cases contem-
plated by section 1 of this act.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into
sanction. force.
