



CHAPTER 77

An Act to amend the Fire Protection Act

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1931]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 11 of the Fire Prevention Act (Revised R. S., c. 180, Statutes, 1925, chapter 180), as amended by the acts 18^{s. 11, re-} George V, chapter 65, section 5, and 20 George V, chapter 79, section 1, is replaced by the following:

“11. It shall be lawful for the Lieutenant-Governor ^{Grant for} in Council to appropriate annually a sum of not more than ^{fire pre-} two hundred thousand dollars out of the consolidated ^{vention.} revenue fund of the Province, to the giving of premiums to town, village or rural municipalities which efficaciously protect themselves against fire, to the satisfaction of the commissioner.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. ^{force.}
