



CHAPTER 80

An Act to amend the Child Protection Tuberculosis Act

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1931]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Child Protection Tuberculosis Act (Revised R. S., c. Statutes, 1925, chapter 186B, as enacted by the act 20^{186B, s. 4a,} George V, chapter 83, section 1), is amended by adding^{added.} thereto, after section 4 thereof, the following section:

“**4a.** Notwithstanding any existing law, the school Admission boards of municipalities inhabited by pupils of school of pupils. age shall be bound to admit the latter to the schools, on the same footing as any other child domiciled in the said municipalities. Compensation as determined by the Pro-Compensa- vincial Secretary may, nevertheless, be paid by the Provin- tion. cial Bureau of Health to each school board concerned, for the education of such pupils.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into sanction. force.
