



## CHAPTER 86

### An Act to amend the Burial Act

*[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1931]*

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 3 of the Burial Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, R. S., c. 208, chapter 208) is amended by replacing the first paragraph <sup>s. 3, am.</sup> thereof by the following:

**“3.** No interment shall be proceeded with, before the <sup>Formalities</sup> officer appointed for the registration of acts of civil status <sup>preceding</sup> has been handed a certificate establishing the cause of death, <sup>interment.</sup> as prescribed by section 141 of the Quebec Public Health Act (Chap. 186), or the transportation permit prescribed by section 142 of the said Quebec Public Health Act.”

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming into</sup> sanction. <sup>force.</sup>
