



CHAPTER 99

An Act respecting stray dogs in certain territory not organized as a municipality

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1931]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Revised Statutes, 1925, are amended by adding thereto, after chapter 264A thereof, as enacted by the act 19 George V, chapter 71, section 1, the following chapter: R. S., e. 264B. added.

"CHAPTER 264B

"AN ACT RESPECTING STRAY DOGS IN CERTAIN TERRITORY

"1. This act may be cited as the *Stray Dogs Act*. Short title.

"2. In all territory not organized as a municipality in that portion of the North Shore of the Gulf of the St. Lawrence, from the eastern boundary of the township of Letellier as far as the eastern boundary of Blanc-Sablon, every person who owns a dog or who has the custody or possession thereof is forbidden to allow it to wander about, between the 15th of June and 15th of October of the same year. Forbidden to allow dogs to wander in certain territory.

"3. Every person found guilty of an infringement of this act shall be liable, in addition to paying the costs, to a fine of at least two dollars and at most ten dollars, and, upon failure to pay the fine and costs, to an imprisonment of thirty days. Penalty for individuals.

Penalty for
firms, etc.

If the infringement is committed by a firm or a corporation, in the case of the firm, each member residing in the territory described in this act, and, in the case of the corporation, the president and directors, shall be liable to the penalties above enacted."

Coming into
force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
