



## CHAPTER 102

An Act to amend articles 1220 and 2144 of the Civil Code respecting certain writings executed out of the Province of Quebec

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1931]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 1220 of the Civil Code, as amended by the C. C., art. acts 62 Victoria, chapter 49, section 1; 9 Edward VII, 1220, am. chapter 70, section 1; 3 George V, chapter 47, section 1; 7 George V, chapter 51, section 1; 8 George V, chapter 74, section 1, and 20 George V, chapter 99, section 1, is again amended by replacing the words: "Canadian Commissioner", inserted in paragraph 5 of the said article by the act 8 George V, chapter 74, section 1, by the words: "accredited representative of Canada".

**2.** Article 2144 of the said Code, as amended by the acts Id., art 8 George V, chapter 74, section 2, and 20 George V, chapter 2144, am. 99, section 2, is again amended by replacing the words: "Canadian Commissioner", in the second line of the second paragraph thereof, by the words: "accredited representative of Canada".

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into force. sanction.
