



CHAPTER 103

An Act to amend Article 1530 of the Civil Code

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1931]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 1530 of the Civil Code is amended by adding C. C., art.
thereto the following paragraph: 1530, am.

“In the case of an animal stricken with tuberculosis, the Delay for
redhibitory action shall be deemed to be brought within a redhibitory
reasonable delay if so brought within ninety days of the action.
delivery, and, in such case, the burden of proof that the
animal was not so stricken at the time of delivery shall
lie on the vendor.”
