



## CHAPTER 109

An Act to amend Article 94 of the Code of Civil Procedure

*[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1931]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 94 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as amended C. C. P., art. by the acts 63 Victoria, chapter 41, section 1; 1 Edward VII, chapter 33, section 1; 4 George V, chapter 68, section 1, and 4 George V, chapter 69, section 1, is again amended by adding to paragraph 5 thereof the following paragraph:

“In matters of contract by agency, or resulting from an order given to or received by an agent, mandatary or representative, the place where the contract was made is that where the consent of the party, to whom the thing forming the object of the contract is deliverable, was given, or that where the order was given to or received by the said agent, mandatary or representative.”

**2.** This act shall not affect pending cases.
