



CHAPTER 111

An Act to amend Article 361 of the Code of Civil Procedure

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1931]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 361 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as amend- C. C. P., art.
ed by the act 7 George V, chapter 55, section 2, is again ^{361, am.}
amended by adding thereto, after the third paragraph
thereof, the following paragraph:
