



CHAPTER 111

An Act to amend Article 361 of the Code of Civil Procedure

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1931]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 361 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as amended by the act 7 George V, chapter 55, section 2, is again amended by adding thereto, after the third paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:

“Nevertheless, if the party has no attorney, the judge, on a return attesting that the articulated facts cannot be served upon him personally or at his domicile, because he is outside of the Province or absconding, may order the mode of service which he deems suitable.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
