



CHAPTER 113

An Act to amend Article 1317 of the Code of Civil Procedure

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1931]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 1317 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as C. C. P., art. amended by the act 5 George V, chapter 82, section 2, is 1317, am. again amended by adding thereto, after the paragraph enacted by the said act 5 George V, chapter 82, section 2, the following paragraph:

“Notwithstanding the above provisions, when the Lieu- Loose leaf tenant-Governor in Council has ordered that the index to index to im- immoveables shall be made in a registration division in a loose leaf volume, such volume shall be authenticated by writing at the top of each leaf, before any entry is made Authentication thereon, an attestation, in the following form, or any other form to the same effect, to which the registrar or his deputy shall affix his signature before the prothonotary or his deputy.”
