



CHAPTER 114

An Act to amend the Municipal Code

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1931]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 90 of the Municipal Code is amended by adding thereto, after the first paragraph thereof, the following paragraph: Mun. Code, art. 90, am.

“The county council may, however, enact by resolution, that the appointment of the warden be made during the month of June in each year.” Appointment of warden.

2. Article 293 of the said Code is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph: Mun. Code, art. 293, am.

“Notwithstanding the provisions of this article and of article 296, the Minister of Municipal Affairs, on evidence as he may deem sufficient of the inability of a municipality to provide itself with the ballot-papers prescribed by article 296, may authorize such municipality to use typewritten ballot-papers.” When use of typewritten ballot-papers may be authorized.

3. Article 324 of the said Code is amended by replacing the word: “two”, in the second line thereof, by the word: “five”. Mun. Code, art. 324, am.

4. Article 376 of the said Code is replaced by the following: Mun. Code, art. 376, replaced.

“**376.** A public notice convening a public meeting of the electors of the municipality for the purpose of approving or disapproving of a by-law and voting thereon must be posted at least fifteen days before the holding of the meeting, in the places where by-laws are ordinarily posted.” Approval of by-law by public meeting.

Mun. Code, art. 377, repealed. **5.** Article 377 of the said Code is repealed.

Mun. Code, art. 408, am. **6.** Article 408 of the said Code, as amended by the acts 10 George V, chapter 82, section 2; 11 George V, chapter 48, section 25; 16 George V, chapter 69, section 1; 17 George V, chapter 74, section 11; 18 George V, chapter 94, section 14, and 20 George V, chapter 103, section 15, is again amended by adding thereto, after paragraph 5a thereof, as enacted by the act 11 George V, chapter 48, section 25, the following paragraph:

Renewal of contract. "5b. At the expiration of the term mentioned in any contract entered into between the council and any public utility company, respecting the supplying of electricity for light, heat and power by such company to the municipality which itself distributes same to its ratepayers, the Quebec Public Service Commission, on a petition to that effect, may order that the contract be extended or renewed on such other or similar terms, prices and conditions, as it may determine."

Mun. Code, art. 769, am. **7.** Article 769 of the said Code, as replaced by the act 12 George V, chapter 80, section 12, and amended by the act 18 George V, chapter 94, section 20, is again amended by replacing paragraph 6 thereof, by the following paragraph:

Certificate. "6. A certificate of the publication of such notice;".

Coming into force. **8.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
