



## CHAPTER 118

An Act to amend the Municipal Code respecting the powers of county councils

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1931]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

- 1.** Article 451 of the Municipal Code is replaced by the following: Mun. Code, art. 451, replaced.

**“451.** The powers conferred by articles 447 and 448, on the county corporation and the board of delegates, may be also exercised by them in regard to any road, bridge or water-course, not yet authorized or made, in the same manner as for a road, bridge or water-course already made.” Extension of exercise of certain powers.
- 2.** The said Code is amended by adding thereto, after article 451a, as enacted by the act 14 George V, chapter 86, section 1, the following article: Mun. Code, art. 451b, added.

**“451b.** The county corporation or the board of delegates possesses and exercises, in regard to any road, bridge or water-course which is by law or is declared to be a county road, bridge or water-course, all the powers of a local council.” County corporation vested with powers of local council in certain case.
- 3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
