



CHAPTER 123

An Act to amend the charter of the city of Montreal

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1931]

WHEREAS Jules Crépeau, heretofore director of municipal services of the city of Montreal, has, by his petition, represented that he was in the service of the city of Montreal for forty-two years and that in the month of September, 1930, His Honour the Mayor of Montreal indicated to him that the majority of the aldermen of the city of Montreal wished him to retire and that such majority were disposed to grant him six months' salary and to not oppose a pension being voted to him under article 477 of the charter of the city of Montreal;

Whereas, on the 23rd of September, 1930, the said Jules Crépeau wrote a letter to His Honour the Mayor of Montreal, agreeing to resign as director of municipal services, if such was the council's wish, on the conditions above-mentioned;

Whereas, at a special meeting of the Montreal city council, held on the 29th day of September, 1930, the said letter from the said Jules Crépeau to His Honour the Mayor of Montreal, was read and submitted to the council and, on motion of alderman Savignac, the resignation of the said Jules Crépeau was accepted on the conditions mentioned in the said letter of the 23rd of September, 1930;

Whereas from the foregoing it results that a contract was entered into between the said Jules Crépeau and the city of Montreal regarding the granting of a pension based on article 477 of the charter of the city of Montreal;

Whereas the city of Montreal had not then the right to grant the pension provided for in the said article, to the director of municipal services of the city of Montreal, although it had such right for other municipal officers;

Whereas it is expedient to grant the city of Montreal the necessary powers to carry out its obligations to the said Jules Crépeau as to the granting of a pension;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Certain pension authorized.

1. The council of the city of Montreal is authorized to give effect to the contract entered into between the city of Montreal and the director of municipal services who was in the city's services for forty-two years and whose resignation was accepted by the council of the city of Montreal on the 29th of September, 1930, and to pay him a pension based on the fourth paragraph of article 477 of the charter of the city of Montreal.

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
