



CHAPTER 132

An Act to amend the Act to incorporate the Town of Isle Maligne

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1931]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The act 14 George V, chapter 97, is amended by adding thereto, after section 14 thereof, the following sections:

14a. The erection of the territory of the Town of Isle Maligne into a separate school municipality, by Order-in-Council bearing No. 1297, adopted on the 18th of June, 1930, and approved by the Lieutenant-Governor on the 20th of June, 1930, is declared to be effective and in force from the 1st of July, 1930, and to have been valid for all legal purposes from that date.

14b. The election of school commissioners, the notice of dissent, the election of school trustees and all acts of the said commissioners and trustees are declared valid provided that they have been done in all other respects in conformity with the provisions of the Education Act.

14c. The school commissioners of the Town of Isle Maligne are authorized to reimburse and pay to Duke-Price Power Company, Limited, the sum of twenty-three thousand five hundred dollars, being a portion of the amount paid by the said company to the school commissioners of St. Joseph-d'Alma and to the school commissioners of St. Cœur-de-Marie, and may, by resolution without other approval or formality, effect all loans necessary for such purpose."

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
