



CHAPTER 162

An Act respecting the American Can Company

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1931]

WHEREAS the American Can Company has, by its Preamble. petition, represented that on the 29th of December, 1930, the executive committee of the city of Montreal adopted the by-law No. 1110 of the city of Montreal, whereby permission was given to it to erect two overhead bridges over Jeanne d'Arc street, in the city of Montreal, to connect the buildings belonging to the company, on the east side of Jeanne d'Arc street and erected on lots Nos. 14-313, 314, 315, 316, 317, 318, 319, 320, 321, 322, 323, 324, 312A, 312B, 312D, 312E and part of No. 361 of the incorporated village of Hochelaga, with the buildings which the said company intends to erect on the west side of the said street, on the lots bearing the numbers 713, 714, 715, 98, 99, 100, 101, 102, 103, 104, 105 and 106 inclusively of original lot No. 17 of the cadastre of the incorporated village of Hochelaga;

That the council of the city of Montreal adopted the same by-law on the 3rd of February, 1931;

That the permission so granted is to the advantage of the city of Montreal as well as the petitioner, for the buildings which the latter intends to erect will constitute a plant that will cost over five hundred thousand dollars and give employment to a number of workmen;

That there is grave doubt as to the validity of the said by-law, if unratified by an act of the Legislature authorizing at the same time the making and signing of a notarial deed between the parties, setting forth the conditions of the said by-law;

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer contained in the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

By-law
ratified.

1. The by-law of the city of Montreal, bearing number 1110, adopted by the executive committee on the 29th of December, 1930, and by the council of the said city, on the 3rd of February, 1931, permitting the American Can Company to construct, reconstruct and maintain two overhead bridges over Jeanne d'Arc street, in the city of Montreal, for the purpose of connecting the buildings, belonging to the company, erected on lots Nos. 14-313, 314, 315, 316, 317, 318, 319, 320, 321, 322, 323, 324, 312A, 312B, 312D, 312E and part of No. 361 of the incorporated village of Hochelaga, with the buildings which the company intends to erect on the west side of the said street, on the lots bearing the numbers 713, 714, 715, 98, 99, 100, 101, 102, 103, 104, 105 and 106 inclusively of original lot No. 17 of the cadastre of the incorporated village of Hochelaga, is confirmed, ratified and declared valid, legal and binding for all purposes whatsoever, and the notarial deed also, stipulated in article 10 of the said by-law, is hereby permitted and is also declared valid, legal and binding upon the parties from the date of its execution and signature.

Coming into

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
