



CHAPTER 174

An Act to ratify by-law No. 55 of the council of the municipality of the parish of Notre-Dame-du-Mont-Carmel and a resolution of the school commissioners of the same municipality, dated the 31st of October, 1930.

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1931]

WHEREAS the corporation of the parish of Notre-Dame-du-Mont-Carmel and the school commissioners for the said parish of Notre-Dame-du-Mont-Carmel, have, by their petition, represented:

That The Shawinigan Water and Power Company, a corporation having its principal place of business in the city of Montreal, is owner of a water power and power plants situated on the river St. Maurice at the place called La Gabelle, within the territory of the parish of Notre-Dame-du-Mont-Carmel;

That hitherto difficulties have existed between the municipality and the company respecting the valuation of the property of the company;

That on the 25th of October, 1930, the municipal council of the parish of Notre-Dame-du-Mont-Carmel unanimously adopted a by-law to establish and fix the real value of the property of The Shawinigan Water & Power Company at the sum of one million, five hundred and sixty-four thousand and seventy dollars, for a period of ten years, to be computed from the 1st of January, 1931;

That the said by-law was submitted for the approval of the electors who are owners in the said municipality, and was approved by all those who voted except three dissenting;

That the by-law was further approved by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

That it is expedient that the by-law be ratified and approved by the Legislature to have force and effect;

That on the 31st of October, 1930, the school commissioners for the said parish of Notre-Dame-du-Mont-Carmel, unanimously passed and adopted a resolution to the same effect, namely: to establish and fix the value of the property of The Shawinigan Water & Power Company, at the sum of one million, five hundred and sixty-four thousand and seventy dollars;

That it is expedient that the said resolution be ratified by the Legislature to give it force and effect;

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer contained in the said petition.

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. By-law No. 55 of the municipality of the parish of Notre-Dame-du-Mont-Carmel, establishing and fixing the real value of certain property of The Shawinigan Water & Power Company, at the sum of one million, five hundred and sixty-four thousand and seventy dollars, for a period of ten years to be computed from the 1st of January, 1931, is hereby ratified and confirmed and declared valid and obligatory as regards the valuation therein contained.

2. The resolution of the school commissioners for the said parish of Notre-Dame-du-Mont-Carmel, dated the 31st of October, 1930, establishing and fixing the valuation of certain property of The Shawinigan Water & Power Company at the sum of one million, five hundred and sixty-four thousand and seventy dollars, for school purposes, for a period of ten years, to be computed from the 1st of January, 1931, is hereby ratified and confirmed and declared valid and obligatory as regards the valuation it contains.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
