



CHAPTER 186

An Act to authorize the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Emile A. Jeannotte to the practice of medicine, surgery and obstetrics, after examination

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1931]

WHEREAS Emile A. Jeannotte, of the city of West-Preamble. Mount, district of Montreal, has, by his petition, represented:

That in September, 1903, he was admitted as a student of medicine in Laval University, Montreal, and followed the medical course of the said university for the four years then required;

That in September, 1907, Laval University, at Montreal, granted him a diploma of Doctor of Medicine;

That he began to attend the courses of the said university without obtaining his admission to the study of medicine;

That only in May, 1930, did he obtain from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province, after passing the required examinations in Letters and in Science, the permit authorizing him to study medicine, which through unavoidable circumstances he was unable to obtain before entering the said university;

That, in view of the foregoing, the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec has consented to a bill being presented to authorize the petitioner to practise medicine, after having undergone certain examinations required by the said College;

Whereas it is expedient to grant his prayer to the above effect;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Emile A. Jeannotte among its members, and to grant him the license to practise medicine, surgery and obstetrics in the Province of Quebec, after he shall have undergone the professional examinations before the Provincial Medical Board.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
