



CHAPTER 5

An Act to make a grant to the Lower St. Lawrence Transportation, Limited, for the establishing of a navigation service on the Lower St. Lawrence River between the North and South Shores

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1930]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may authorize the Provincial Treasurer to pay, out of the consolidated revenue fund, upon certificates from the Minister of Colonization, Game and Fisheries, to the Lower St. Lawrence Transportation, Limited, (*Compagnie de transport du Bas St. Laurent Limitée*), an annual amount of fifty thousand dollars, for a period of time not to exceed five years, for the establishment and maintenance, by the company, during the navigation season of each of the years 1930 to 1934, inclusive, of regular boat services between the South Shore and the North Shore of the St. Lawrence River:

a. from Rimouski to Pointe-aux-Outardes, calling at intermediate points; Grant to Lower St. Lawrence Transportation, Limited.

b. from Rimouski to Comeau Bay and Trinity Bay; and

c. from Matane to Trinity Bay and Seven Islands,—

under the terms and conditions of a contract to be entered into for such purposes between the Minister of Colonization, Game and Fisheries and the said company. Boat services. Contract.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
