



## CHAPTER 25

An Act to amend the Quebec License Act respecting hotels

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1930]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Quebec License Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, R. S., c. 25, chapter 25) is amended by inserting therein, after section 32 thereof, the following section:

“**32a.** The owner or keeper of a hotel or their representatives may expel any person frequenting it or staying therein who is unable to justify his presence either as a customer or lodger in the hotel, or as the guest of a customer or lodger in the hotel, or as having lawful business to transact with a customer or lodger of the hotel.”

Expulsion of certain persons from hotels.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
