



CHAPTER 49

An Act to amend the Cities and Towns' Act respecting aid to hospitals or charitable institutions

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1930]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 473 of the Cities and Towns' Act (Revised R. S., c. 102, Statutes, 1925, chapter 102), as amended by the act 19 s. 473, am. George V, chapter 35, section 7, is again amended by adding to paragraph 6 thereof the following paragraph:

"Such grants to such hospitals or charitable institutions may be paid by equal annual instalments over a period of not more than twenty-five years, and, in such case, the by-law does not require to have the approval of the elector-proprietors, but it must be approved by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council."
