



## CHAPTER 52

### An Act to amend the Municipal Aid Prohibition Act

*[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1930]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 2 of the Municipal Aid Prohibition Act R. S., c. 116,  
(Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 116) is amended by s. 2, am.  
adding thereto, after sub-paragraph 4 thereof, the follow-  
ing paragraph:

"However, any municipality, other than a city or town Aid by mu-  
municipality, may, by by-law, contribute, by means of a nicipality in  
loan or otherwise, to not more than half of the cost of the certain  
installation, within and without the territory of the muni- cases.  
cipality, of poles, wires, conduits and apparatus for the  
transmission of electricity in such municipality. Such  
by-law, even if it enacts a loan, shall be subject only to  
the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council."

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanc-Coming into  
tion. force.
