



CHAPTER 53

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1925, respecting the alienation of certain public utilities

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1930]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Revised Statutes, 1925, are amended by inserting R. S., c. therein, after chapter 118 thereof, the following chapter: ^{118A,} _{added.}

“CHAPTER 118A

“AN ACT RESPECTING THE ALIENATION OF MUNICIPAL PUBLIC UTILITIES

“**1.** This act may be cited as *Municipal Public Utilities Sales Act*. Short title.

“**2.** No municipality may sell, cede or otherwise alienate any public utility service belonging to it, except by a by-law approved by the affirmative vote in number and in value of the elector-proprietors who have voted, and by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.” Procedure to sell, etc. public utility.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
