



CHAPTER 54

An Act to amend the Workmen's Dwelling Act

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1930]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Workmen's Dwelling Act (Revised Statutes, R. S., c. 128, 1925, chapter 128) is amended by adding thereto, after s. 7a, added section 7 thereof, the following section:

"**7a.** Without prejudice to the hypothecary recourse, in the event of the non-payment of the sums due for advances or loans made under this act, at their maturity respectively, the council of a municipality having made such advances or loans may, by resolution, order the clerk or secretary-treasurer to draw up and furnish it with a statement, within the delay fixed by it, showing the lands and buildings affected by such loans, the sums due and the names and address of the last registered owner of such lands and buildings.

When such statement has been so furnished, the council may order the clerk or secretary-treasurer to sell such lands and buildings.

The provisions of sections 549 to 563, inclusively, and of sections 568 to 571, inclusively, of the Cities and Towns' Act (Chap. 102) shall apply to the sale, so ordered, of such lands and buildings, *mutatis mutandis*."

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
