



CHAPTER 56

An Act to amend the Education Act respecting loan resolutions

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1930]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 244a of the Education Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 133), as enacted by the act 16 George V, chapter 41. section 1, is replaced by the following: R. S., c. 133, s. 244a, replaced.

“**244a.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, on the report of the Minister of Municipal Affairs and on the recommendation of the Superintendent, amend a loan resolution submitted for his approval, upon application therefor contained in a subsequent resolution of the school corporation which passed the said resolution and without the necessity of the giving of the public notices prescribed by sections 243 and 307, provided that such amendments do not change the object of the loan and do not increase the amount of the loan and do not increase the rate of interest by more than one per cent of the capital of the loan, and that they neither extend nor shorten the term for reimbursement.” Power of Lt.-Gov. in C., to amend loan resolution. Proviso.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
