



## CHAPTER 66

### An Act to amend the Courts of Justice Act

*[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1930]*

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 216 of the Courts of Justice Act (Revised R. S., c. 145 Statutes, 1925, chapter 145) is amended by replacing the <sup>s. 216, am.</sup> last paragraph thereof by the following:

“The administrative jurisdiction of each of such chief <sup>Jurisdiction</sup> justices shall respectively extend to each of the appellate <sup>of chief</sup> divisions as established by article 47 of the Code of Civil <sup>justices.</sup> Procedure.

In particular, such chief justices shall have, respecting <sup>Powers.</sup> the Court of the Sessions of the Peace, the same powers as the chief justice and the acting chief justice of the Superior Court respecting the said Superior Court and the judges of such Court.

The judges of the Sessions of the Peace shall be subject <sup>Idem.</sup> to the supervision, orders and control of such chief justices as regards the distribution of cases, the holding of sittings and generally all administrative matters concerning them.”

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming into</sup> sanction. <sup>force.</sup>
