



CHAPTER 67

An Act respecting the pension of judges of the Sessions of the Peace, police magistrates and district magistrates.

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1930]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follow:

1. Section 241*a* of Courts of Justice Act (Revised Stat. R. S. c. 145. ues, 1925, chapter 145), as enacted by the act 17 George s. 241*a*, am. V, chapter 49, section 1, is amended:

a. By replacing the figures and letter: "241*a*", in the first line of the first paragraph thereof, by the following figures and letter: "241*a*. 1.";

b. By adding thereto, after the second paragraph thereof, the following:

"2. From and after the 4th of April, 1930, a pension of ^{Pension to} twelve hundred dollars per annum shall be paid to the ^{widow of} widow of a judge of the Sessions of the Peace, which judge ^{judge of} sessions. died on or before the 21st of November, 1927.

Such pension shall be paid to such widow during her ^{Duration.} lifetime and while she remains a widow."

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. force.
