



## CHAPTER 72

### An Act to amend the Judicial Statistics Act

*[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1930]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 2 of the Judicial Statistics Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 163) is amended: R. S., c. 163,  
s. 2, am.

*a.* By replacing paragraph 8 thereof by the following:

“8. By each clerk of the Crown and by each clerk of the peace, a statement or return of all criminal or penal matters submitted in their district to the judges of the sessions, to the police magistrates, to the district magistrates, and to the justices of the peace, based upon the entries made in their respective books, and, moreover, in the case of a clerk of the peace, upon the reports received from the clerks of the justices of the peace in compliance with the provisions of subdivision 5 of Division II of Part III of the Courts of Justice Act (Chap. 145);”;

*b.* By repealing paragraphs 9, 11 and 13 thereof.

**2.** The said act is amended by repealing forms No. 8, No. 11 and No. 13 thereof. R. S., c. 163,  
Forms 8, 11  
and 13, re-  
pealed.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the date which it shall please the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to fix by proclamation. Coming into  
force.
