



CHAPTER 86

An Act to amend the Quebec Dental Act

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1930]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Quebec Dental Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, R. S., c. 216, chapter 216) is amended by adding thereto, after section 85 thereof, the following section:

“**85a.** Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the Board may grant the license to practise dental surgery to any male person who, having followed for at least four years the regular and complete course in one or more Canadian universities outside of this Province, has obtained the degree of Doctor of Dental Surgery, provided however that such person comply with the following conditions:

a. Produces evidence showing that, before his admission to study dental surgery, he had followed preliminary studies deemed by the Board, equivalent at least to those required of candidates from this Province, or passes successfully the examination of the Board for obtaining a certificate of competency;

b. Passes successfully, before the representatives of the College, the final examination as required from candidates of the Province;

c. Pays the fees exacted by the Provincial Board of Dental Surgery to cover the expenses occasioned by such examination.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
