



CHAPTER 89

An Act to amend the Telegraph Companies' Act

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1930]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 9 of the Telegraph Companies' Act (Revised R. S., c. 235, Statutes, 1925, chapter 235) is amended: s. 9, am.

a. By adding after the word: "across", in the fifth line of the first paragraph thereof, the words: "any land or";

b. By adding after the first paragraph thereof the following paragraph:

"When the company wishes to put up its poles and lines and cannot agree with the owner of the land respecting the compensation to be paid, it may, by complying, as to procedure, with the provisions of the Quebec Railway Act (Chap. 230) and its amendments, expropriate the portion of land strictly necessary to put up its poles thereon, with, in addition, a servitude conveying the right to put up its poles and wires and the right to pass over the land to repair and keep them in good order."

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
