



CHAPTER 93

An Act to amend the Expropriation Act

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1930]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 5 of the Expropriation Act (Revised Statutes, R. S., c. 263. 1925, chapter 263) is amended by replacing the words: ^{s. 5, am.}
“the Attorney-General”, in the sixth line thereof, by the
words: “a judge of the Superior Court, having jurisdiction
in the district within which is situated the land to be ex-
propriated or where the right in question is to be exercised,”.

2. Section 6 of the said act is amended:

Id., s. 6, am.

a. By replacing the words: “the Attorney-General”, in
the fourth line of the first paragraph thereof, by the words:
“a judge of the Superior Court, having jurisdiction in the
district within which is situated the land to be expropriated
or where the right in question is to be exercised,”;

b. By replacing the word: “Attorney-General”, in the
first and second lines of the third paragraph thereof, by the
word: “judge”.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into}
sanction. ^{force.}
