



## CHAPTER 98

An Act to amend articles 1056 and 2262 of the Civil Code

[Assented to, the 20th of March, 1930]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

- 1.** Article 1056 of the Civil Code is amended: C. C., art.  
1056, am.

  - a.* By replacing the words: "*père, mère et enfants*", in the third and fourth lines of the first paragraph of the French text thereof, by the words: "*ascendants et ses descendants*";
  - b.* By replacing the last paragraph of the English text thereof by the following:  
"These actions are independent of criminal proceedings to which the parties may be liable and are without prejudice thereto." Criminal

- 2.** The French text of article 2262 of the said Code is amended by replacing the word: "*injures*", in the first line of paragraph 2 thereof, by the words: "*lésions ou blessures*". C. C., art.
