



CHAPTER 99

An Act to amend articles 1220 and 2144 of the Civil Code
respecting certain writings executed out of the
Province of Quebec

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1930]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 1220 of the Civil Code, as amended by the C. C., art.
acts 62 Victoria, chapter 49, section 1; 9 Edward VII 1220, am.
chapter 70, section 1; 3 George V, chapter 47, section 1; 7
George V, chapter 51, section 1, and 8 George V, chapter
74, section 1, is again amended by inserting therein, after
the word: "authenticated", in the third line of paragraph
5 thereof, but before the words added by the act 3 George
V, chapter 47, section 1, the words: "before a notary public
or".

2. Article 2144 of the said Code, as amended by the act Id., art.
8 George V, chapter 74, section 2, is again amended by 2144, am.
adding, after the second paragraph thereof, the following
paragraph:

"If it be executed in one of the United States of America, Swearing of
the affidavit may also be sworn to before a notary public affidavit in
in such state." U. S.

3. This act shall apply to powers of attorney and me- Provisions
morial made since the 1st of January, 1925. applicable.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into
sanction. force.
