



CHAPTER 102

An Act to amend the Code of Civil Procedure respecting judgments of separation of property

[Assented to, the 20th of March, 1930]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 1097 of the Code of Civil Procedure is replaced by the following: C.C.P., art. 1097, replaced.

“1097. Every judgment ordering separation of property must be inscribed, without delay, in a special register, intituled: “Separation of Property”, kept in a place open to the public in the office of the court which rendered the judgment; and such inscription and the date thereof must be mentioned at the end of such judgment in the register in which it is recorded.” Inscription of judgments ordering separation of property.

2. This act shall come into force on the first day of January, 1931. Coming into force.
