



## CHAPTER 102

An Act to amend the Code of Civil Procedure respecting judgments of separation of property

*[Assented to, the 20th of March, 1930]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 1097 of the Code of Civil Procedure is replaced by the following: C.C.P., art. 1097, replaced.

**"1097.** Every judgment ordering separation of property must be inscribed, without delay, in a special register, intituled: "Separation of Property", kept in a place open to the public in the office of the court which rendered the judgment; and such inscription and the date thereof must be mentioned at the end of such judgment in the register in which it is recorded."Inscription of judgments ordering separation of property.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the first day of January, 1931. Coming into force.
