



CHAPTER 104

An Act to replace articles 75 and 760 of the Municipal Code

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1930]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 75 of the Municipal Code is replaced by the following: M. C., art. 75, replaced.

"75. The office of the corporation of a rural municipality or of its officers, and the place where the council holds its sittings, may be established in a village, town, or city municipality situated in proximity to such rural municipality." Office, etc.

"2. Article 760 of the said Code is replaced by the following: M. C., art. 760, replaced.

"760. Every bond must specify:

1. The name of the corporation by which it is issued;
2. The by-law authorizing the issue thereof;
3. The amount for which it is given;
4. The rate of interest per annum;
5. The time and place of payment of both principal and interest;
6. The date of issue.

It must also bear the signature of the head of the council or of any other person authorized to sign it, as well as that of the secretary-treasurer. Signature.

Every bond heretofore or hereafter issued shall be deemed to be validly signed if it bears the signature of the head of the council and of the secretary-treasurer in office at the date the bond bears or at the time it was issued. Idem.

It must also contain all provisions necessary to give effect to the intentions of the by-law under which it is issued." Provisions necessary.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
