



CHAPTER 159

An Act respecting the trustees for the parish of St. Philippe de La Reine

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1930]

WHEREAS the trustees for the parish of St. Philippe de Preamble.
La Reine have, by their petition represented:

That in 1921 an assessment was imposed according to law, to guarantee a sum of eighteen thousand dollars and to yield in twenty years the amount of thirty-four thousand five hundred dollars;

That during the year 1922 the trustees, finding that the amount of the above assessment would not suffice to pay the necessary expenses for the erection and repairs, a supplementary assessment was imposed, and the latter was homologated in 1925;

That, on the 8th of January, 1928, the trustees, duly authorized according to law and by order-in-council to revise the two existing acts of assessment above mentioned, drew up a new act of assessment which was unanimously accepted and homologated on the 30th of July, 1929;

That doubts have arisen respecting the validity of such homologation by the civil commissioners;

That the trustees thought it expedient to ask the commissioners to repeal all their orders in order to enable the trustees to begin over all the proceedings upon the legality whereof doubts had arisen;

That the said civil commissioners have recommended the passing of this act;

That it is in the public interest that any doubt as to the validity of such homologation of the act of assessment made on the 30th of July, 1929, be removed and that it is necessary to ratify the said homologation;

Whereas the petitioners have prayed for the passing of an act for the above purposes and it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Homologation
validated.

1. The homologation by the commissioners for the civil erection of parishes in the diocese of Haileybury, dated the 30th of July, 1929, as evidenced by the extract from the minute-book of the deliberations of the said commissioners, is validated and such homologation of the said act of assessment shall take the place of any approval required by the provisions of the Parish and Fabrique Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 197).

Payment of
instalments.

2. The trustees shall be empowered to exact, in accordance with the said act of assessment of 1929, payment of the instalments due on such assessment, as well as of the instalments to become due.

Payments
declared
valid.

3. All payments made to the trustees under the said act are declared valid.

Acts of as-
sessment
cease to
have force.

4. The act of assessment of 1921, revised in 1927, and the act of assessment of 1925 shall cease to have force and effect on the date of the coming into force of this act.

Coming into
force.

5. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
