



CHAPTER 183

An Act to authorize the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Joseph Goldberg to the practice of medicine, after examination

[Assented to, the 20th of March, 1930]

WHEREAS Joseph Goldberg, of the city and district Preamble.
of Montreal, and now of Binghampton, New York,
one of the United States, has, by his petition, represented:

That, in 1929, he obtained the degree of Doctor of Medicine from McGill University of Montreal;

That at the time of his entrance on the 2nd of October, 1922, he was unaware that he had to pass an admission examination and consequently, after obtaining his degrees from the college, he found that he was not in accordance with the law and was admitted to the study of medicine in the month of September, 1928;

That, after obtaining his degrees from McGill University, he has since served as intern at a hospital in New York where he now is;

That he now has only to pass, in order to hold all the titles required for a physician and surgeon in this Province, certain examinations and formalities required by the College of Physicians and Surgeons;

That, in view of the foregoing, the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec has consented that a bill be presented to authorize the petitioner to practise medicine, after successfully undergoing the second, third, fourth and fifth year examinations before the Provincial Medical Board;

Whereas the petitioner has prayed for the passing of an act for the above purposes; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Admission

1. The College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Joseph Goldberg amongst its members, and to grant him the required license to practise medicine in the Province of Quebec, after he shall have successfully undergone the second, third, fourth and fifth year examinations, before the Provincial Medical Board.
